<b>Eye Contact</b>	Does not attempt to look at audience at all, reads notes the entire time	Only focuses attention to one particular part of the class, does not scan audience	Occasionally looks at someone or some groups during presentation	Constantly looks at someone or some group at all times.
<b>Facial expressions</b>	Has either a deadpan expression or shows a conflicting expression during entire presentation	Occasionally display both a deadpan and conflicting expression during presentation	Occasionally demonstrates either a deadpan OR conflicting expression during presentation	Gives audience clues as to what the content of the presentation is about; appropriate expression, never notice a deadpan or conflicting expression.
<b>Posture</b>	Sits during presentation or slumps	Occasionally slumps or leans during presentation	Stands up straight most of the time.	Stands up straight with both feet on the ground. Has professional presence.
<b>Vocal skills</b>	Voice is too quiet to be heard; statements are muffled., unclear.	Voice is quiet but can be heard slightly; statements are somewhat unclear.	Voice is firm but could be louder; statements are articulated clearly.	Voice is loud and firm; statements are articulated clearly.
<b>Visuals</b>	Visuals are inappropriate, incomplete, unprofessional, and are not clearly labeled.	Visuals are appropriate, but lack clarity and are incomplete and/or not labeled.	Visuals are appropriate, clearly labeled and complete. However, a professional touch is missing.	Visuals are appropriate, complete, professional, and clearly labeled.
